As part of the binding process for your client's environmental coverage, we require a signed and dated ACE Westchester Environmental application. Why? The policy and application together stipulate that the insured's signature on our application is a warranty by the insured that the information provided to us is correct and that our offer of coverage relies upon that warranty.

We often receive an application other than our own as part of the initial submission. In our ongoing quest to simplify the binding process, we are now able to bind environmental coverage based upon the information contained in a legible, complete, signed and dated application from another carrier, if it provides adequate information to allow us to underwrite the account. We retain the warranty provisions of our policy by attaching an endorsement that identifies the other application and stipulates that we are relying on it as the insured's warranty of the information provided in the application.

This process will allow us to streamline the acceptance and confirmation of your bind orders. It will eliminate the step of having to go back to your agent - who then has to go back to the insured - to get a second signed and completed application to complete the processing of the binder.
